
Reaching

• With food prices high and government services dwindling South Carroll Food Pantry is on the front line helping hundreds of families access nutritious groceries.

 Community Table serves up food and community three times a week.

- Our ministries with children and youth provide space for faith & leadership development for our own kids and hundreds of Eldersburg young people seeking a space to belong, explore, and serve.
- Hope Rising therapeutic and peer support groups, counseling services and workshops are helping our neighbors heal; many are beginning to establish roots at Wesley!
- We sponsored a mission team, repaired a roof on Greendale UMC Zimbabwe, and packaged 500 hygiene kits & 10,000 meals.
- In everything we do we invite the Lord's grace to help us be peacemakers, who advocate for justice and infuse compassion into every aspect of our community.

- Our ability to be a positive presence in our community lies in our commitment to faith development rooted in prayer and scripture.
- At VBS 400 children and youth discovered God's constant love for navigating a "wild world."
- Over 40 persons explored faith and chose to attach themselves to Christ's family through New Members classes, middle school and now high school confirmation!
- Sunday night ministry has sprung up with classes for men, moms, and parents, 2 new children's choirs, and children's ministry.
- Our Prayer Guide and Devotionals are helping our congregation grow in faith and are being shared to reach 100s around the nation.
- Prayer alarms are sounding at 7:14 all around the "burg".


Sustaining our life-giving ministry requires broad generosity and careful budgeting. Every dollar matters as we support staff, space, and resources which impact lives every day. While our leaders work diligently to negotiate contracts to manage costs, develop building rental income, and stretch dollars, rising costs are squeezing out funds for ministry.

In 2024 our community generously gave \$992,000.
Still rising costs contributed to a \$16,000 deficit
which was cushioned by \$45,000 savings
from the lack of an associate pastor for half the year.

As of September 30, 2025 giving is \$54,738 behind expenses. While holding costs to the greatest extent possible we forecast the gap between the current giving level, and budgeted expenses to surpass \$100,000 in 2026.

This challenge invites a unified response of prayer, planning, and GENEROSITY!!

Stocks & Bonds

Are you weary of the rise and fall of the market? Gift your assets to Wesley Freedom and enjoy the steady growth and eternal returns gained by investing in the Lord's work. Your high impact gift can be made at a low net cost to you. You will receive a charitable deduction based on the fair market value on the date of the gift and you avoid all federal capital gains taxes!

Qualified Retirement Plans

Do you have a qualified retirement plan, such as a 401(k) or an IRA? Are you required to take a required minimum distribution (RMD)? By making a direct gift from a qualified plan to a charity, known as a qualified charitable donation (QCD), you do not pay any taxes on that money because it is not included in your adjusted gross income. Contribute up to \$105,000 each year.
